



BENCHTOP MAINTENANCE QUARTZ BASED

GENERIC RECOMMENDATION (ALL FINISHES)

- Do not cut directly on the bench top. Use a cutting board when using knives or sharp objects.
- Use heat resistant pads to avoid direct contact with hot surfaces.
- Avoid using steel wool pads, abrasive, and micro-abrasive cleaners. They can damage the surface.
- In case of contact with any staining materials it is recommended to immediately remove with a damp cloth.
- Always remove the protective film before processing the slab

DEEP CLEANING POST INSTALLATION

- During the assembly phase, protect the surface from chemical aggression and possible impacts.
- Try to leave the bench top as clean as possible to avoid using abrasive pad or aggressive detergent, which can damage the surface.
- Use an alkaline detergent suitable for engineered stone and follow the manufacturer's instructions carefully
- Always carry out a preliminary trial of any maintenance product on a non-visible area to verify the final aesthetic effect.

DAILY CLEAN

- Never, ever use strong chemical products (caustic soda, hydrochloric acid and paint stripper) on your quartz surfaces
- Use neutral detergent

SPECIAL TREATMENT

- For Velvet Touch and Chenille finishes a protective treatment is recommended prior to start of use.
